
## A Great and Terrible King: Edward I and the Forging of Britain

The longest-lived of Englands medieval kings, he fathered fifteen children with his first wife, Eleanor of Castile, and, after her death, he erected the Eleanor Crosses?the grandest funeral monuments ever fashioned for an English monarch. In this book, Marc Morris examines afresh the forces that drove Edward throughout his relentless career: his character, Christian faith, and his sense of Englands destiny?a sense shaped in particular by the tales of the legendary King Arthur. He also explores the competing reasons that led Edwards opponents (including Robert Bruce) to resist him.
