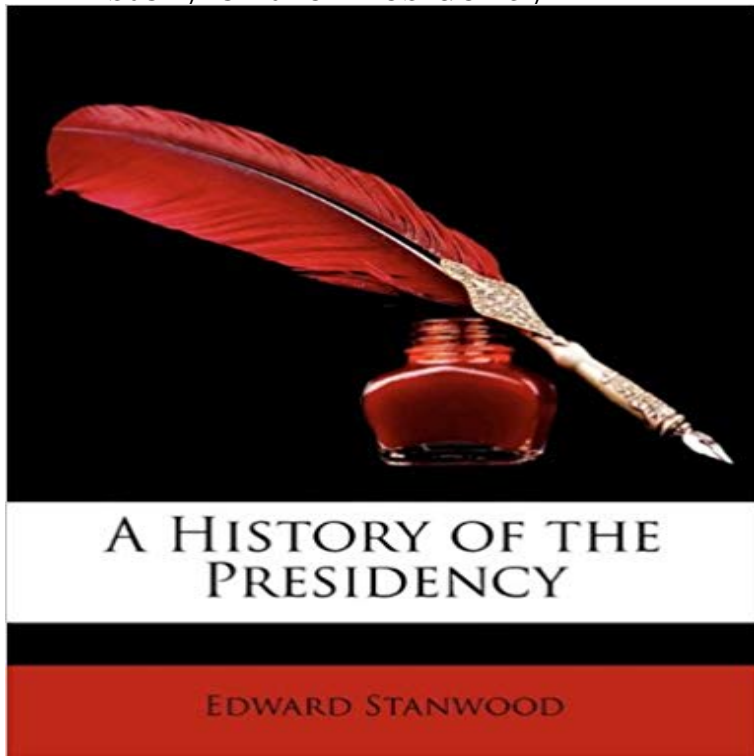


## A History of the Presidency
