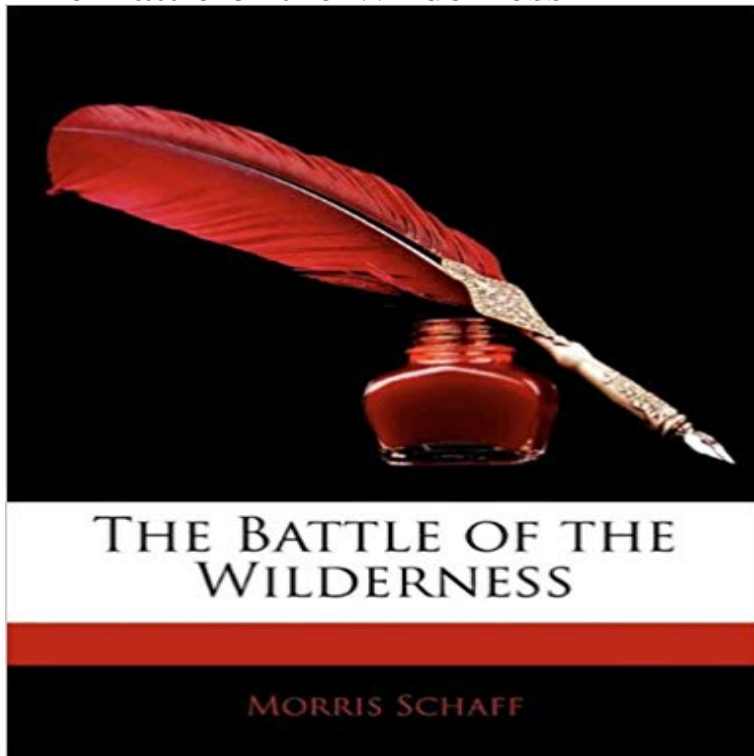


The Battle of the Wilderness
