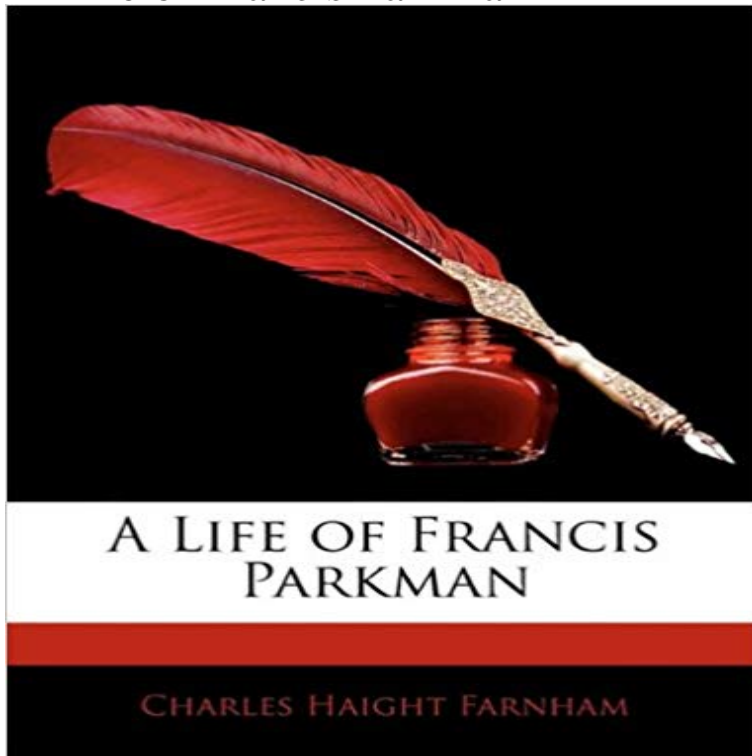


## A Life of Francis Parkman
