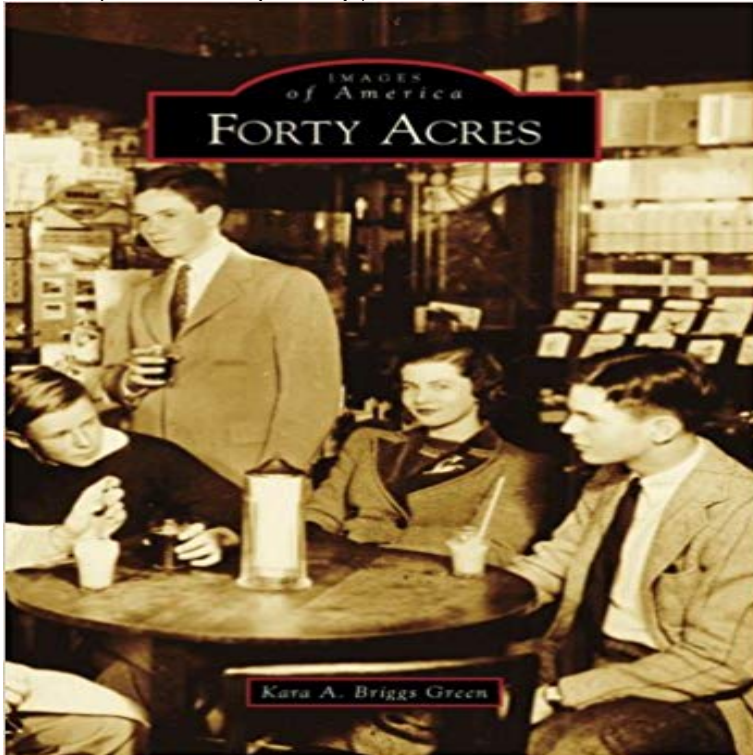


## Forty Acres (Images of America: Delaware)
