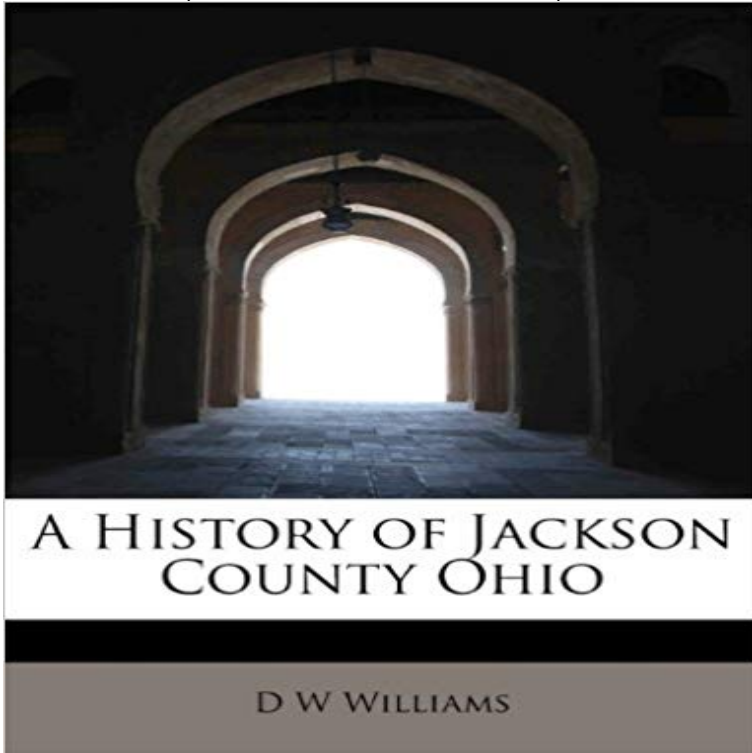


## A History of Jackson County Ohio
