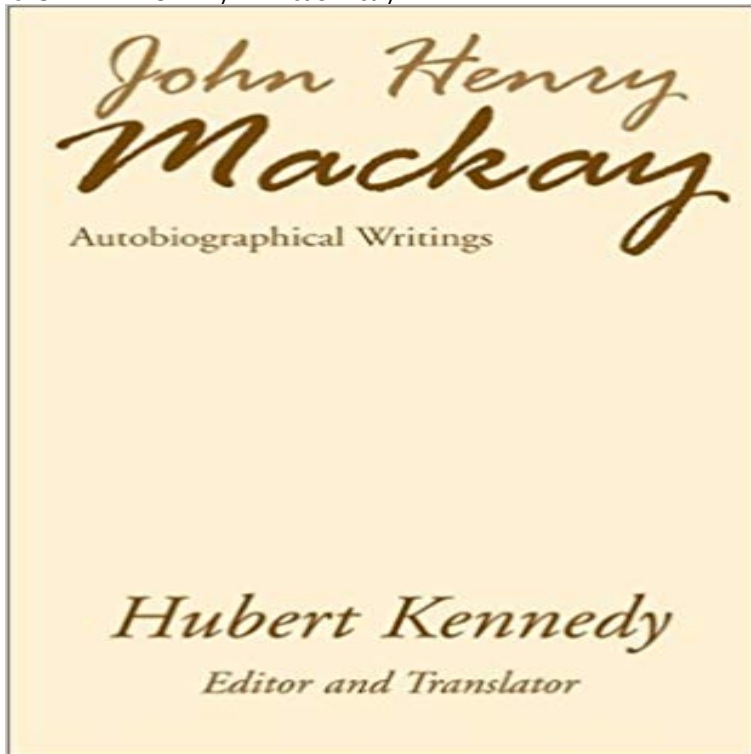


John Henry Mackay
