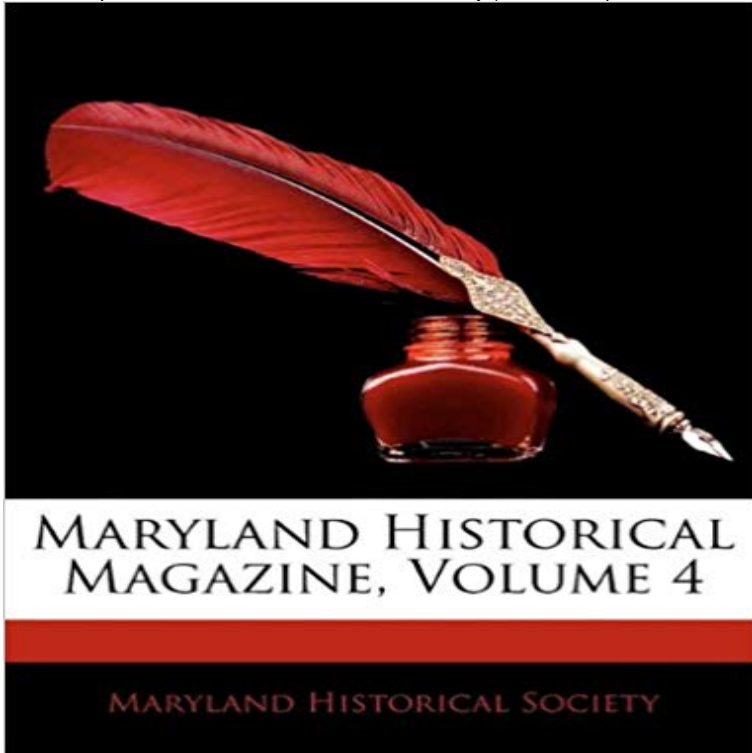


## Maryland Historical Magazine, Volume 4
