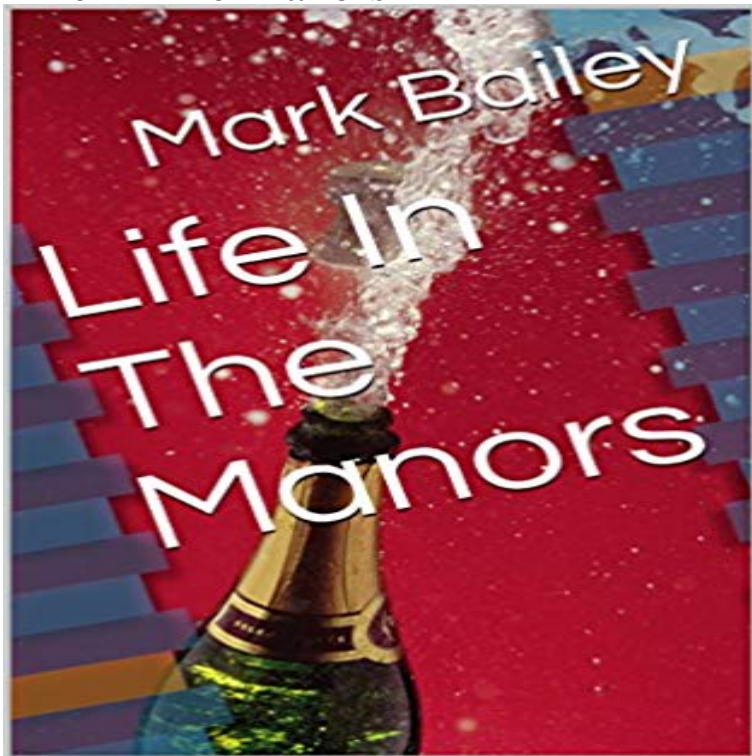


Life In The Manors
