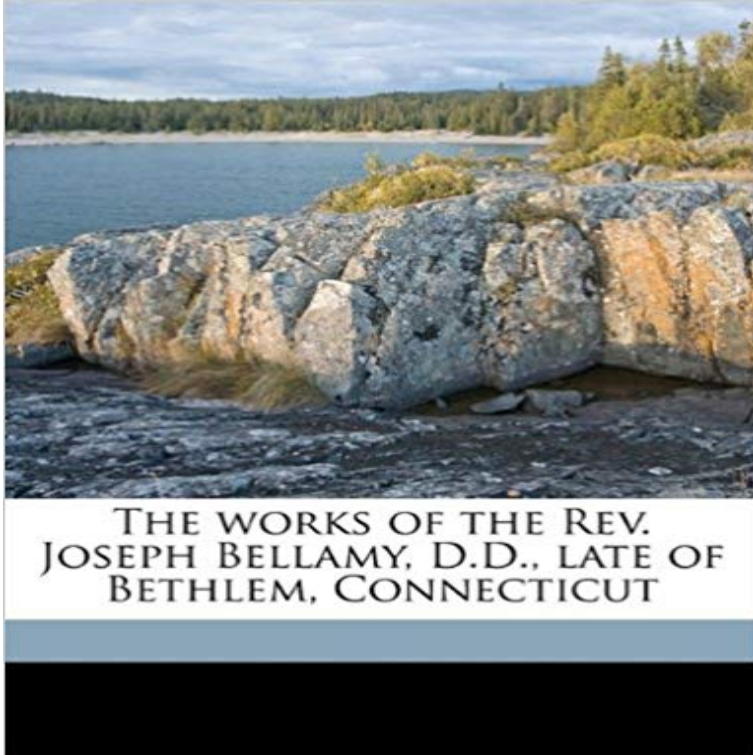


# The works of the Rev. Joseph Bellamy, D.D., late of Bethlem, Connecticut
