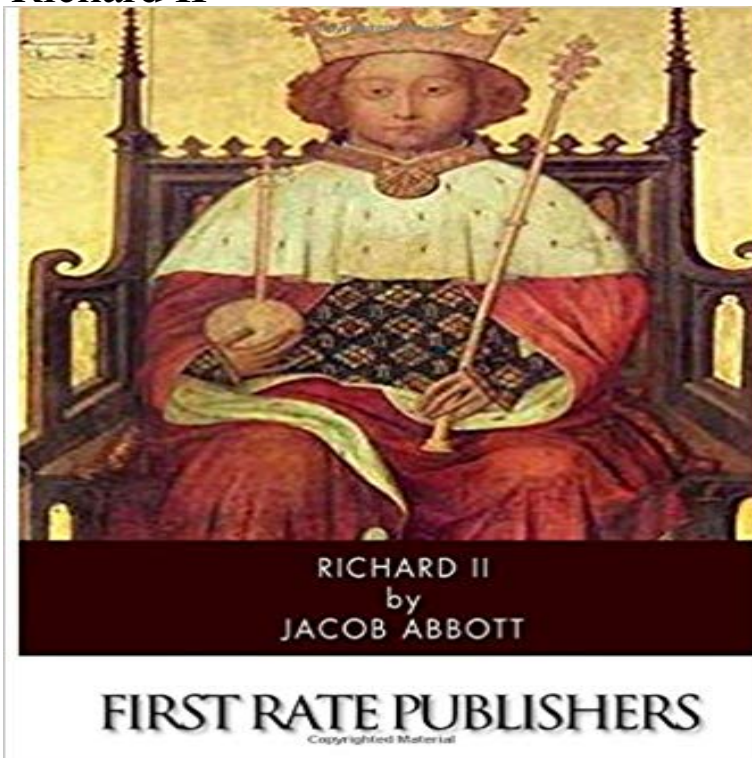


Richard II
