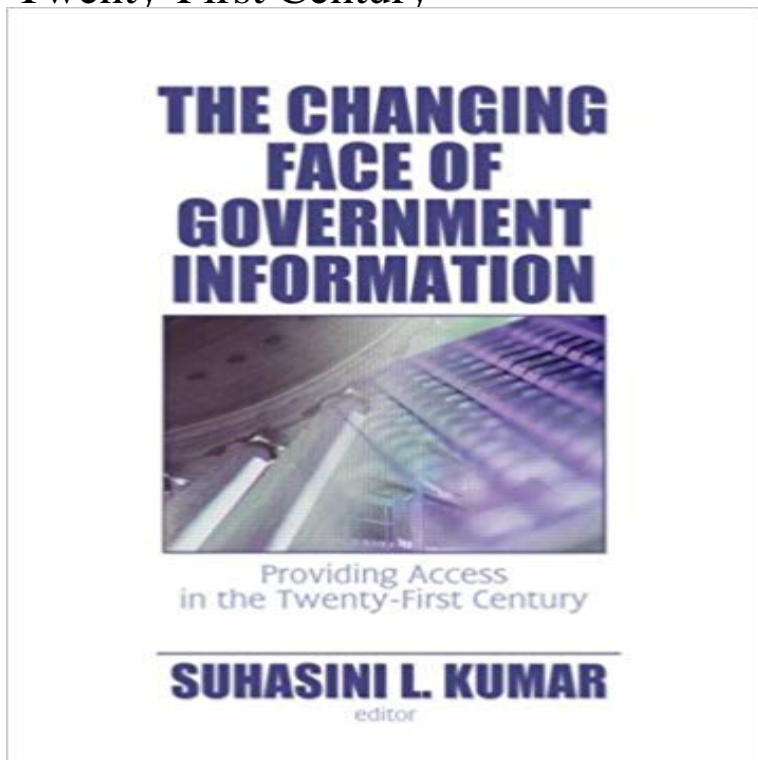


# The Changing Face of Government Information: Providing Access in the Twenty-First Century
