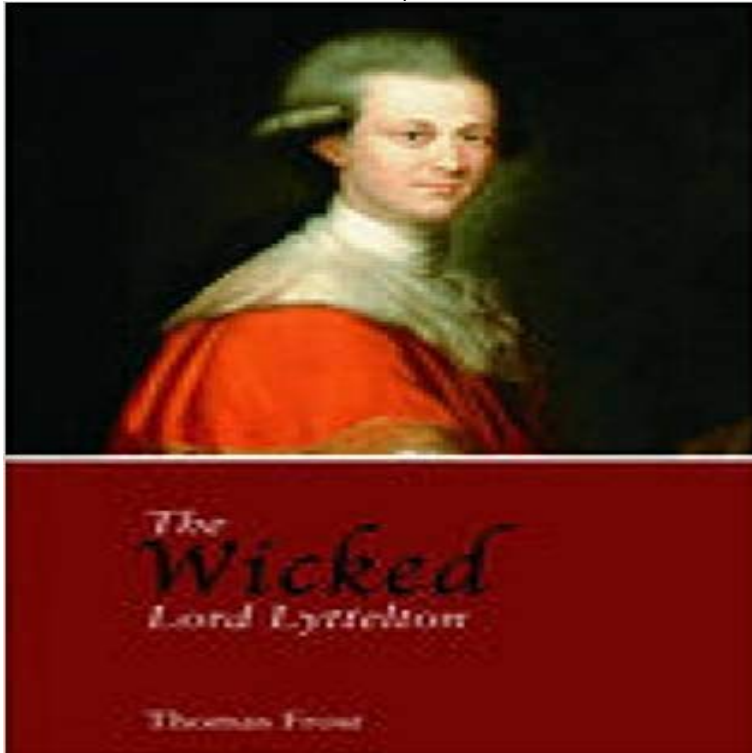


The Wicked Lord Lyttelton
