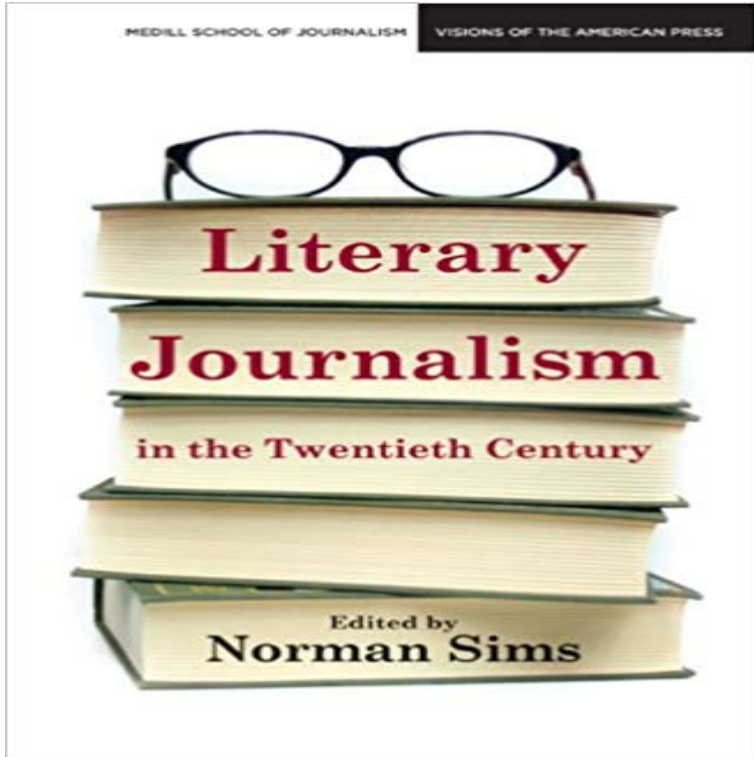


# Literary Journalism in the Twentieth Century (Medill School of Journalism Visions of the American Press)
